
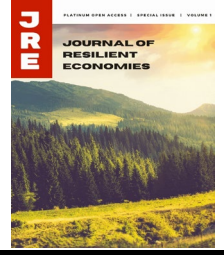




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Editorial: Resilience for Empowered Futures: Nurturing Adaptability Across Diverse Frontiers
